



Sno-Kone Machines

The Sno-Kone machine is simple to operate and a great attraction for any event!

Tips

1. Start the motor and fill gooseneck an inch from the top with ice cubes or 3" X 4" pieces of ice. Hint (the larger the pieces, the better the snow)
2. Push ice down against the cutter head with firm pressure for the best snow (too much = coarse ice; too little = mushy).
3. **DO NOT** force the handle.
4. Put only ice in the gooseneck to prevent damage to the blades.
5. Keep fingers away from shaver body when motor is running to prevent injury.
